






Bavaria's economy: Primary industries






Bavaria's foreign trade: Strong exports for years







Bavaria's tax environment: Competing with low tax countries in Europe and overseas

- One of the most competitive tax systems among big industrialized countries
- Germany's overall corporate tax burden for companies = average of 29.83 %
- Bavaria's Corporate lowest tax burden is 23.88%
- Corporate taxation in Germany
 - corporate income tax 15 % nationwide
 - solidarity surcharge 0.825 % nationwide
 - trade tax (municipal tax) 7%-14%


